

International Letter of Introduction Eligibility

Eligible

- (1) When a member is planning to **attend** a local Scouting event or activity and all information for the event is supplied (including dates and venue) and the contact details of the event organiser are provided; or
- (2) When a member is planning to **visit** a local Scout Group and the date and location of the visit are confirmed, and the contact details for the Group Leader or Leader in Charge are provided.

NOT Eligible

- Private holiday even if there is a "chance" of meeting Scouts.
- Travel to Scouting properties on a personal itinerary – including but not limited to Brownsea Island, Gilwell Park, Baden-Powell House, Kandersteg International Scout Centre, Philmont Scout Ranch.
- Visit to the National Scout Headquarters or Scout Shop or Scout Museum of any other country.
- Attendance at a public visitors day of any overseas Scouting event. (As distinct from being a registered attendee of the event that is fully participating in the event program.)
- Representing Scouts Australia at an overseas meeting or other function. (These must be registered separately as a dedicated event in the OLEMS database.)
- Representing Scouts Australia as an approved member of an Australian Contingent or Branch Friendship Tour. (Contingent registration replaces the requirement for an International Letter of Introduction).

The cost of the International Letter of Introduction (including two Australian scarves and delivery) is \$50.
