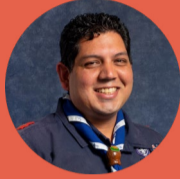

Sensory Awareness

During this session we will explore the concept of behaviour and the relationship between sensory input and psychological output. Participants will learn to identify the underlying causes to behaviours of concern and make causal links between real behavioural challenges experienced in Scouting and the underlying cause using a behavioural analysis approach. Participants will develop skills and an understanding of the mechanics of varying strategies useful in eliciting positive behavioural responses.
