## ELIGIBILITY

### Youth Participant

- You need to be born between 13 August 2005 and 1 August 2009 inclusive (i.e. minimum age 14 years and not have had your 18th birthday)
- You need to be an invested member of Scouts Australia in either the Scouts or Venturer section

### Adult Line Leader or International Service Team (IST)

- Be a registered member of Scouts Australia as either a Rover Scout or an Adult Leader;
- Be recommended as suitable to attend by your Group Leader or next role up from you.

## COST

The Jamboree cost (excluding any Optional Post Tour) is \$5,800.

### Includes:

- The World Jamboree Fee
- All activities, excluding the Optional Post Tour
- Your return flights to and from Australian nominated departure points
- All internal airfares, transfers and bus tours inside South Korea
- All meals and accommodation from the time you leave home until the time you get back, excluding the Optional Post
- Contingent Kit (Backpack, Travel Bag, Shirts, Badges, Australian International Scarf etc)
- Travel Insurance
- Contingent Fees
