Why does my role exist?

The Food House Logistics Manager role exists to manage the specific logistical challenges of the Food House Contingent. This is a unique opportunity to assist in the management of Australia's first Food House as part of the expected 10-12 International Food House's from around the world.

The Logistics Manager works closely with the Food House Contingent Leader, Head Chef and Front of House Manager as part of the Food House Management Team. Your role will ensure all supplies are ordered and freight services arrive in time for the opening of WSJ 2023 Korea.

Where do I fit in?

As the Logistics Manager, you will report directly to the Food House Contingent Leader. You will be responsible for planning and co-ordinating the logistical requirements for the Food House Contingent supplies including freight from Australia to Korea and return, as required, and liaison with the WSJ Korea, Food House Management Team. You will have one direct report to assist in your planning and stock management.

You will also work closely with the Australian Contingent Logistics Director to ensure we minimise duplication of effort and have considered all logistic options to minimise our overall costs.

How much time is required?

You will be required to commit a significant amount of time for this role. The first 6 - 9 months will start high with about 2-3 hours a week as we set up the Contingent Team and our initial planning and budgeting. After this, it could be up to anything from 5+ hours per week, as we get closer to the Jamboree.

Applicants should ensure they have the flexibility in their time to be able to accommodate this significant contribution taking into account their work and study requirements. They should be available during the lead up to and the full duration of the event including pre and post tours. This is a volunteer position.
