Plan>

1. Collect 4 LARGE plastic bags as a minimum and label them with "Plastic", "Waste", "Recycling", "10c bottles".
2. Gather your Patrol/team of 6+ people.
3. Select an area to pick up litter and rubbish in your local bushland/city/town and set activity boundaries.

NOTE: High rubbish areas such as the sides of roads, pathways, or coastlines are good areas to target.

Do>

1. Arrive at the destination and pick up litter. Place the items you collect into the relevant bags.
2. Have a competition for who can collect the most plastic waste! See if you can work together in teams.
3. Be sure to stay within the activity boundaries and set a time of return.
4. Return the 10c bottles to the nearest return and earn!

Review>

3. Discuss how you can impact your local area in making a better world with less plastic or litter.
