## Plan>

1. Identify a body of water nearby. This could be the beach, a lake, a river or something else.
2. Prepare containers to collect rubbish. These could be hessian bags, reusable plastic tubs or any other reusable container.
3. Make sure to take gloves and any other protective equipment you may need.

## Do>

1. With your Patrol, visit your chosen body of water and collect rubbish.
2. Carefully separate items that are recyclable from general rubbish.
3. Choose one disposable plastic item, and decide how to replace it.

For example, disposable plastic bottles could be replaced by refillable bottles or flasks. Plastic cups could be replaced with reusable cups. Plastic straws could be replaced with paper straws.

4. Place all rubbish and recyclables that you collect in the correct bins for disposal.
