Plan>

1. Gather a stack of sustainable and recycled paper (as a minimum 1 per person).

2. Ensure there are enough different coloured colouring pencils that can be shared between 2-4 people.

3. Cut up a few pieces of paper into little squares and write a different country onto each square.

4. Research some examples of popular images for each country in case participants need help with ideas.

Do>

1. Place all the written countries into a hat and have been individual draws a country from the hat.

2. All participants have 5 minutes to draw an image that identifies that country!

3. The Activity Leader can share some examples if needed.

Review>

1. What did you learn about the different country?

2. What was the inspiration for your artwork?

3. Next time you do this activity, what country would you like to draw and why?

Consider having participants draw a famous location in the world and having the rest of the group guess which country the image is from.
