How to make payments

Payments to attend KISC100 Australian Contingent can only be made online through OLEMS (the platform you applied through). We accept Visa & MasterCard only.

- 1. Log into your account
- 2. https://registrations.international.scouts.com.au/Login.asp
- 3. Click on KISC2023 under 'My Events'.
- 4. Click on the status menu.
- 5. Click on the "Make a Payment" button on the right-hand side above the summary of payments table.
- 6. Tick the checkbox of the instalment you wish to pay.
- 7. Then click 'Process Transaction' you will receive confirmation if your payment has been approved or declined.
- 8. (Optional but advised) Download a receipt from the status page.

The Contingent reserves the right to refuse any application at any time, in which case a full refund will be made.

Withdrawal policy

Members choosing to withdraw from the Contingent must notify the Contingent Leader in writing as soon as possible. Since many expenses must be paid well before our departure, it is not possible to provide full refunds upon withdrawal. The following table highlights the amount of any refund payable.

Health & Fitness

As our trip is still a little way in the future, we know things can change with your health between now and when we depart, so if anything changes, please log back into OLEMS and update your application. Please be honest with your health and wellbeing needs – the more our Health and Wellbeing Team know, the better we can support you when in Switzerland. These details can be updated whenever, and as many times as you need! It's better to have too much information than not enough!

In regard to physical fitness, getting ready for our trip can start now! It's important to be as fit as you can for the trip because the Swiss alps make Australian mountains look like little, tiny hills! Getting out walking and hiking as much as you can before the trip will help you get the most out of our adventure!

We'll also be providing some suggested fitness tips and tricks to help you along the way so keep an eye out.



Passports

To travel to Switzerland, you will need a current passport with an expiry date of no earlier than 15 January 2024. If you do not currently have a passport, or it expires before or during the trip to Switzerland, you need to make arrangements now to apply for or to renew your passport.

You can pick up a passport application form at any Australia Post outlet or find more information online at www.passports.gov.au

Passports can take some time to arrange, so we recommend you follow this up NOW. Once you have your passport details, please ensure they are updated in the 'Travel' section of your application.

Our Program Requirements

Reminder: All youth need to be on OAS Stage 4 for camping and have 10 nights under canvas before we depart – it helps you to be prepared for the event by ensuring you have the skills and experience to be able to handle two weeks away from home and in a tent

Check your references!

Sign into your application and double check that your references have completed their part. If they are yet to respond, please chase them up as this is showing your application as incomplete.
