## **Contingent Registrations**

Applications for International Contingents observe a strict closing date where all eligible Youth Members that submit their application AND pay their deposit <u>before the closing date</u> are automatically accepted.

Over the past week, the Australian Contingent Team has spent a significant amount of time and energy negotiating with our travel providers to secure arrangements for all registered members to attend the New Zealand Venture.

In response to the unprecedented weather events across Australia in the past week, our Contingent Team volunteers have worked tirelessly to negotiate additional capacity in our travel arrangements.

It is therefore with great pleasure that we can announce that our Team has today had success at securing a limited number of additional positions to join the Australian Contingent! From today (Wednesday 9 March 2022) applications to join the Australian Contingent for the 15th New Zealand Venture have reopened. Applications will close as soon as capacity is reached or no later than Monday 14 March 2022. Anyone that has not paid their deposit by Monday will automatically be rejected. NO FURTHER EXTENSIONS ARE POSSIBLE!








# **Contingent Arrival Day**

All Contingent members are planned to depart your nearest capital city airport on Wednesday 28 December 2022 and arrive at Christchurch where we will overnight at a local Scout Camp before the Venture begins.

## Phase One (Expeditions)

After meeting in Christchurch you'll head off with your Expedition Unit to your very own adventure. You have already selected your preferred Expedition during your application.

All Phase 1 Expeditions will be assigned by the New Zealand Venture Organising

Committee (VOC) and not by the Australian Contingent. We expect confirmation of the final Expedition allocations in the middle of this year with the Expedition payment due on 1 October 2022.

No matter what Expedition you complete, you can be sure that each Expedition will showcase the best of the South Island, with plenty of adrenaline, touring, scenery and fun!

# Phase Two (Onsite)

With the Phase One Expeditions completed, everyone returns to the Venture Site in Mayfield for Phase Two.

Phase Two provides five days of choice for you to decide how to spend your time with an extensive range of on-site activities, offsite adventures, and evening events. It can be as adventurous (or not!) as you like, with as many activities (or time to socialise!) as you wish. The hardest part will be fitting it all in!

# **Optional Post Tour**

All Contingent Members that have selected the Venture Plus or Venture Lead options will travel to Queenstown after Phase Two for the Optional Australian Contingent Post Tour!

You will participate in a 4-day, 4-night post stay following the Venture where you can enjoy all the sights and attractions to be had in the adventure capital of the world!

Several activities are already included in the Contingent Fee, however there will also be the option available to complete additional activities at an extra cost.

On our final night together, and with the adventure drawing to a close, we will celebrate with a special dinner for the Contingent. This will give you the chance to say goodbye to your new mates and prepare yourself for going home the next day.

## **Contingent Departure Day**

Venture Lite and Venture Help members will return to Christchurch Airport for return flights to Australia on Sunday 8 January 2023.

Venture Plus and Venture Lead members will travel to Queenstown Airport for return flights to Australia on Thursday 12 January 2023.

Further information on flight times will be provided at the Orientation Days.

## **Independent Travel**

On advice of the Australian Government, no independent travel is available for members of the Australian Contingent.

#### Passports

To travel to New Zealand with the Contingent you will need a current passport with an expiry date of no earlier than 12 July 2023. We require your passport details by no later than 1 May 2022.

If you do not currently have a passport, or it expires before or during the Venture, you need to apply for or renew your passport as soon as possible. You can pick up a passport application form at any Australia Post outlet or find more information online at www.passports.gov.au.

Passports can take some time to arrange, so we recommend you follow this up NOW. Once you have your passport details, please ensure they are updated in the Travel Details section of your online registration.

#### **Adult Roles**

The Australian Contingent has received a surplus number of adult applications for this event. As a result, we will be working with the New Zealand Venture Organising Committee to complete a selection process. The outcome will be advised as soon as possible.

# **Orientation Days**

We know that you're excited to head on this trip of a lifetime, and we are too! So that we're all on the same page and able to jump straight in to Ignite'23, it is important that you attend the Orientation Day for your nearest capital city. Please note that we are unable to provide payment plans for these payments. We strongly suggest that if you need a payment plan, set up your own bank account and deposit money into that on a regular schedule. When a payment comes due you should have the required amount ready to go.

#### How to make payments

Payments to attend Ignite'23 with the Australian Contingent can only be made through the On-Line Event Management System (OLEMS).

- 2. Select NZV2023 under "My Current Events".
- 3. Click on "Make a Payment" in the menu.
- 4. Tick the checkbox of the instalment you wish to pay and add your Card Details.
- 5. Then click "Process Transaction" and you will receive confirmation that your payment has been approved.

# Withdrawal Policy
