Note: suggest having a spare Contingent shirt, essential medications and a Black Pen



Personal Gear

- All participants have at least OAS Camping Stage 4 to satisfy event eligibility
- Therefore all participants know what gear to take on a camping activity
- Expedition leaders will communicate any special items if they are required (e.g. hiking backpack)



Departure Uniform

- Normal Venturer Scout Uniform Shirt
- Australian Contingent Scarf (using a Friendship Knot)
- Australian Contingent Name Badge

We recommend you wear any Hiking Boots on the flight (if you are taking Hiking Boots) to help clear NZ Customs & Quarantine

NZ Customs & Quarantine



- Biosecurity regulations in NZ are more strict than Australia!
- You must ensure that all camping gear, shoes and other equipment are correctly cleaned and free of potential disease
- NZ Officials will inspect equipment on arrival and confiscate any items that cannot satisfy these requirements on arrival
