
Requirements – Maximum weight for White water rafting – 130kg | Youth under 13 years of age will walk around the Grade 4/5 rapid.

Experience the adrenaline of white water rafting on Kaituna River. Raft the highest commercially rafted waterfall in the world. The Kaituna River is Rotorua Rafting's playground, with an all-Kiwi crew and home to not just one, but three impressive waterfalls – Tutea Falls at 7 metres, Okere Falls and Kaituna Falls. There is no denying - this is for the adrenalin seekers amongst us!

The Kaituna river has been ranked as the best white water rafting in the world due to the kind nature of the river mixed with hair-raising waterfalls.

Neighbouring the famous Lake Rotorua, our Scenic Lake Rotoiti Day tour offers you the chance to see one of New Zealand's best kept secrets.

Paddle past the cascading native bush admiring the classic kiwi baches dotted along the cliffs and coves. Learn the myths and legends of the Maori people linked to the area while you explore the quiet lake and its abundance of birdlife. Soon you will arrive at our secret Glowworm cave on the edge of Lake Rotoiti. Then glide across the lake to the stunning Manupirua Hot Pools, which are only accessible by water. This gives you a chance to relax with the locals in the natural geothermal pools while you admire the beauty of your surroundings.






Journey deep into ancient native forest in small groups, of up to 10 people. Experience New Zealand like it once was from the top of the forest canopy.


HOBBITON


You will journey around the 12-acre set; past Hobbit Holes, the Mill and into the world-famous Green Dragon Inn.


CAVES & KIWIS





Return bus journey from Keswick Christian Camp – 200km

Requirements - Nil



The Waitomo Glowworm Caves tours are made up of two levels. The upper being dry and decorated with stunning, delicate cave formations and the lower level consisting of stream passages, glowworms and the Cathedral, the tallest chamber in the cave.

Next stop is Aranui Cave, it is a magical, mystical place that is steeped in Maori myth and legend. It is named after Ruruku Aranui, the local Maori man who first discovered this previously hidden gem back in 1910.

Begin your tour at the Ruakuri Scenic Reserve, as you take a scenic stroll through an enchanted forest to discover the hidden entrance to Aranui Cave. With no river running through it, Aranui Cave houses little life beyond a colony of native New Zealand cave wetas just inside its natural entrance.

Upon entering the cave, discover the exquisite interior decorations that must be seen to be believed. Your guide will take you along safe boardwalks into narrow chambers to see the finest cave formations of all the caves in Waitomo. The high chambers, magnificent limestone formations and the pale brown, pink and white shades of the huge stalactites in the Aranui Cave are truly spectacular. After visiting the amazing Waitomo Caves, you will head to Otorohanga Kiwi Bird House. There are currently two specialised kiwi nocturnal houses, a huge dome aviary, walk-through wildlife enclosures, ponds, wetlands and tree-lined paths. Listen to the Keepers talks and discover the park on your own.

You then can take a short walk into the local town of Otorohanga and explore the entertaining Kiwiana displays in the Ed Hillary Walkway and selected shop windows, check out the corrugated-iron kiwi sculptures at both entrances to the town and view Kiwiana murals along the main street.


TAUPO VOLCANIC VALLEY EXPLORER





Return bus journey from Keswick Christian Camp – 170km

Requirements - Nil



A short drive from Huka Falls is the town of Taupo. The starting point will be Tongariro South Domain Park where you can have lunch and then head off to explore the town. Perhaps a stop at the famous McDonalds or find the big Taupo sign and get some great photos for the Socials!

After leaving Taupo you will discover the Waimangu Volcanic Valley and Lake Rotomahana with the Full Waimangu Experience. You'll enjoy beautiful walking & hiking trails, woven through a natural geothermal ecosystem. You can explore the world's youngest geothermal valley at your own pace, with walking trails for all abilities and ambitions. Walks vary in length from 1.5km to 4.5km, covering a range of geothermal activity, hot springs, volcanic craters, nature and wildlife. Some highlights to look out for include the world's largest hot spring, the Mt Haszard trail, and the brilliant blue Inferno Crater.

The trails ultimately lead you down to the lake, where you'll enjoy relaxing 45-minute cruise around the tranquil waters of Lake Rotomahana. Throughout the cruise, you'll encounter stunning geothermal activity only accessible by boat, as well as rare native birdlife. You can also listen to the historic stories of the lake, the Pink and White Terraces and the Mount Tarawera eruption from the onboard commentary.

TAURANGA ADVENTURE DAY





Requirements – Minimum height 1.40 metres (Adrenaline Forest)



This isn't just a test of your physical skills - each obstacle can be conquered in different ways, so you'll be stretching your brain as well. Challenges include the Indiana jump, crossed logs, barrels, wrecking balls, a commando flying fox and Tarzan jump.

Nerves will be tested, but the revolutionary Clic-iT safety system, which ensures a continuous connection to the safety line, will always keep you safe.


Then head over to the Waimarino Water & Adventure Park, enjoy your lunch and plan your afternoon on the water. Waimarino Adventure Park is a tranquil paradise situated on the banks of the Wairoa River. This all-inclusive pass gives you full access to all activities including the kayaks and paddleboards for the full day.

Some of the activities at the park include: the blob, rock wall, hydro-slide, tarzan swing, beach volleyball and gladiator pole.


TAURANGA EXPLORER DAY





Return bus journey from Keswick Christian Camp – 150km

Requirements - Nil



Scenic features of our cruise include the Statue of Tangaroa, a diversity of landscapes from untouched white sandy beaches, lush green forests, islands and small village settlements, contrasted by the massive highly developed port infrastructure. Occasionally you may see some seasonal wildlife on your cruise like blue penguins, sea birds or New Zealand fur seals.

After your cruise head to the iconic Mount Maunganui, Mauao, which rises 232 meters from the sea. The walking tracks to the top of this extinct volcano provide 360-degree views which span the entire length of the Bay of Plenty.


After your hike, it's time to head to the Mount hot pools located at the base of the mountain. Mount Hot Pools features three outdoor pools of varying temperatures, two outdoor spas and three indoor private pools.

The three outdoor pools were each built with a specific purpose in mind. The relaxation pool is designed for soaking, the hydrotherapy pool for swimming, walking and play, and the children's pool for young ones to enjoy. Pools ranging from 27° to 40°. Whatever the weather outside, you can bask in the warmth of our hot ocean pools.



SKYLINE GONDOLA & LUGE

Return bus journey from Keswick Christian Camp – 20km

Requirements - Nil


Get ready to jump onboard one of our eight-seater Gondola cabins at Rotorua Skyline and experience spectacular views of Lake Rotorua, the city and steaming geothermal vistas. The 900-metrelong Doppelmayr cableway system will transport you and your friends on a gentle, scenic ride up to the Skyline Rotorua complex. Once at the top, you will head to the luge.



Choose your Luge track – Tiki Tour, Twister, Legend, Ultra or Gravity. With a three-ride ticket you get to explore different tracks on the part go-cart, part toboggan which is gravity-fuelled with full rider control over speed and direction using a unique braking and steering system. Pull back on the handlebars to slow down or stop, release slightly to accelerate and enjoy the ride.
