Why does my role exist?

The International Service Team (IST) Manager role exists to ensure that all adult members of the Contingent to ensure they feel supported and enjoy their time in their role. Whilst the main workload will be at the Moot, during the lead up to the Moot the IST Manager will support and advocate for the IST.

As the IST Manager, you form part of the (CMT) and work with other members of the team to manage the Australian Contingent to the 16th World Scout Moot in Portugal. You will be involved in tackling real world problems, as well as gaining exposure to the other parts of the World Scouting Movement. But most importantly, you help create the event of a lifetime for hundreds of Rover Scouts.

Where do I fit in?

As the IST Manager, you will report directly to the CL. You will be responsible for:

- Maintaining communication between the IST members of the contingent and the CMT
- Monitoring IST health and wellbeing including managing fatigue
- Advocating for the IST members
- Preparing and delivering IST training material.

How much time is required?

You will be required to commit a significant amount of time for this role. The commitment will be 1-4 hours a week until about 12 months out from the event. After this, it could be up to anything from 5-10 hours per week, as we get closer to the Moot.

Applicants should ensure they have the flexibility in their time to be able to accommodate this significant contribution considering their work and study requirements. It is desirable for the successful candidate to be available during the lead up to and the full duration of the event, including pre and post tours. This is a volunteer position.

- Ability to think logically and laterally
- Ability to accept individual ownership/accountability
- Experience in project management is highly regarded.
- Experience with international travel is highly regarded
- Ability to work with spreadsheets

- Comfortable in being challenged and responding to challenges
- Perceived as humble and down to earth
- Committed to ensuring the Australian Contingent is youth-led and adult supported
- Love problem-solving and are passionate about learning and stretching yourself

Interpersonal Skills
