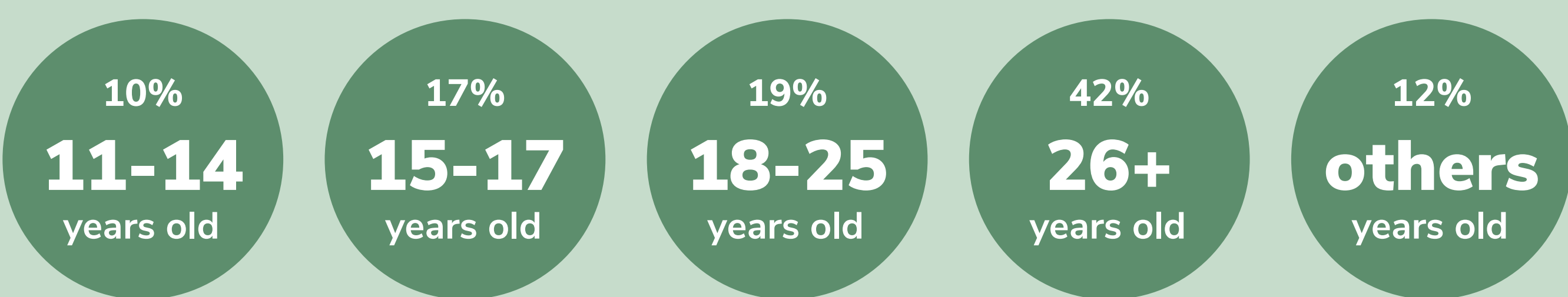

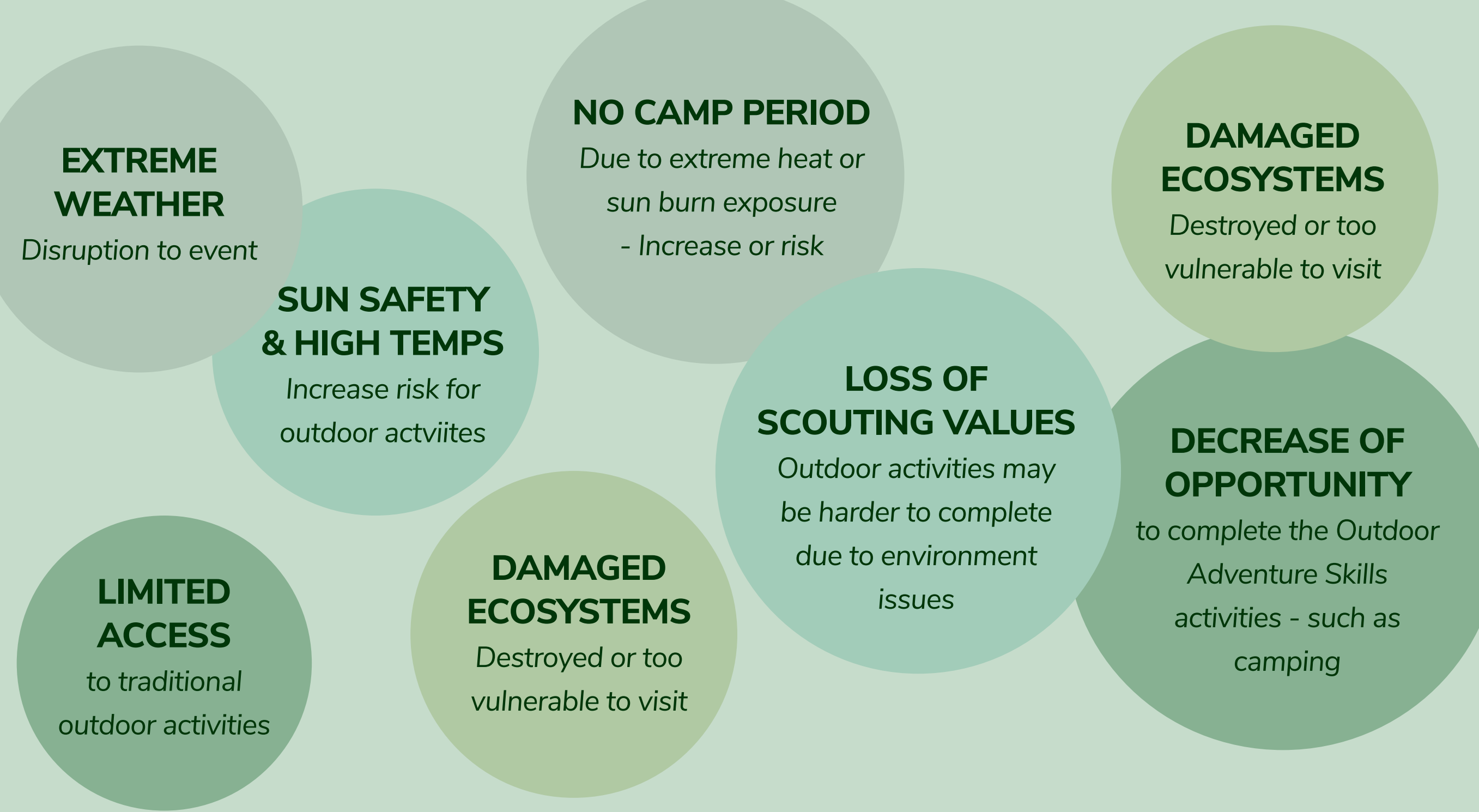

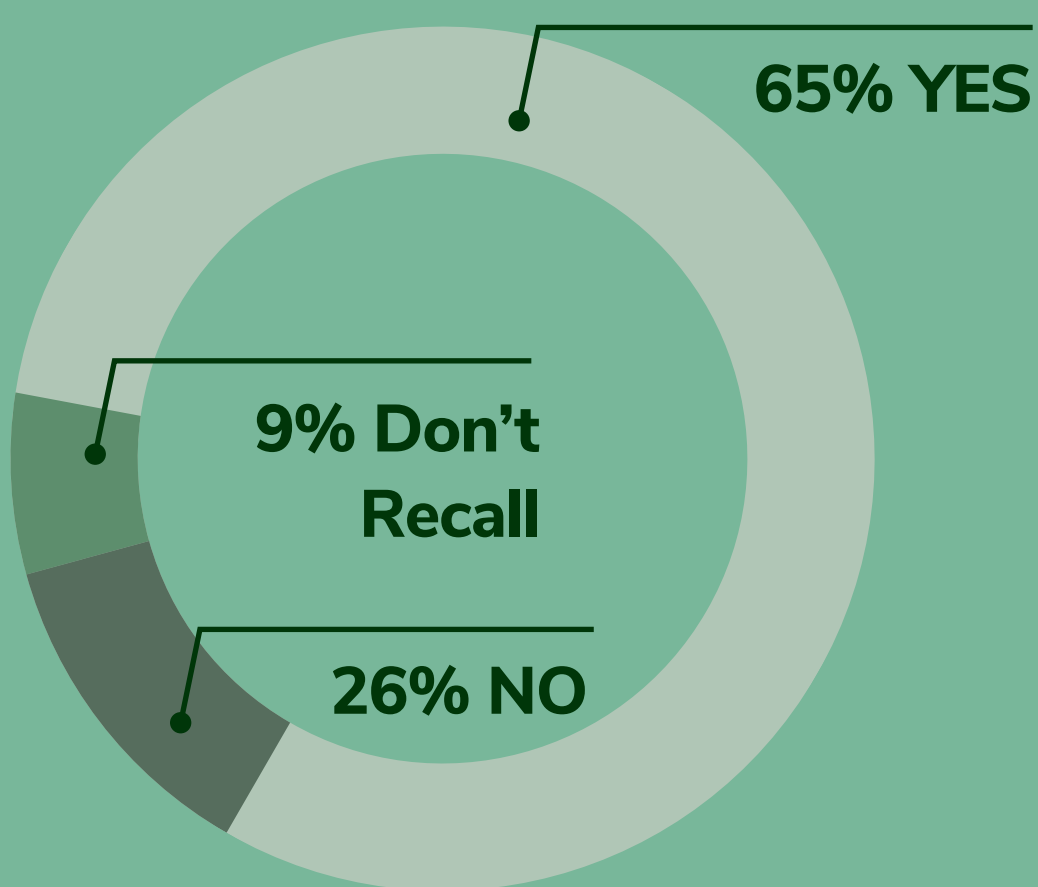
TOP 5 impacts climate changes has at the local community



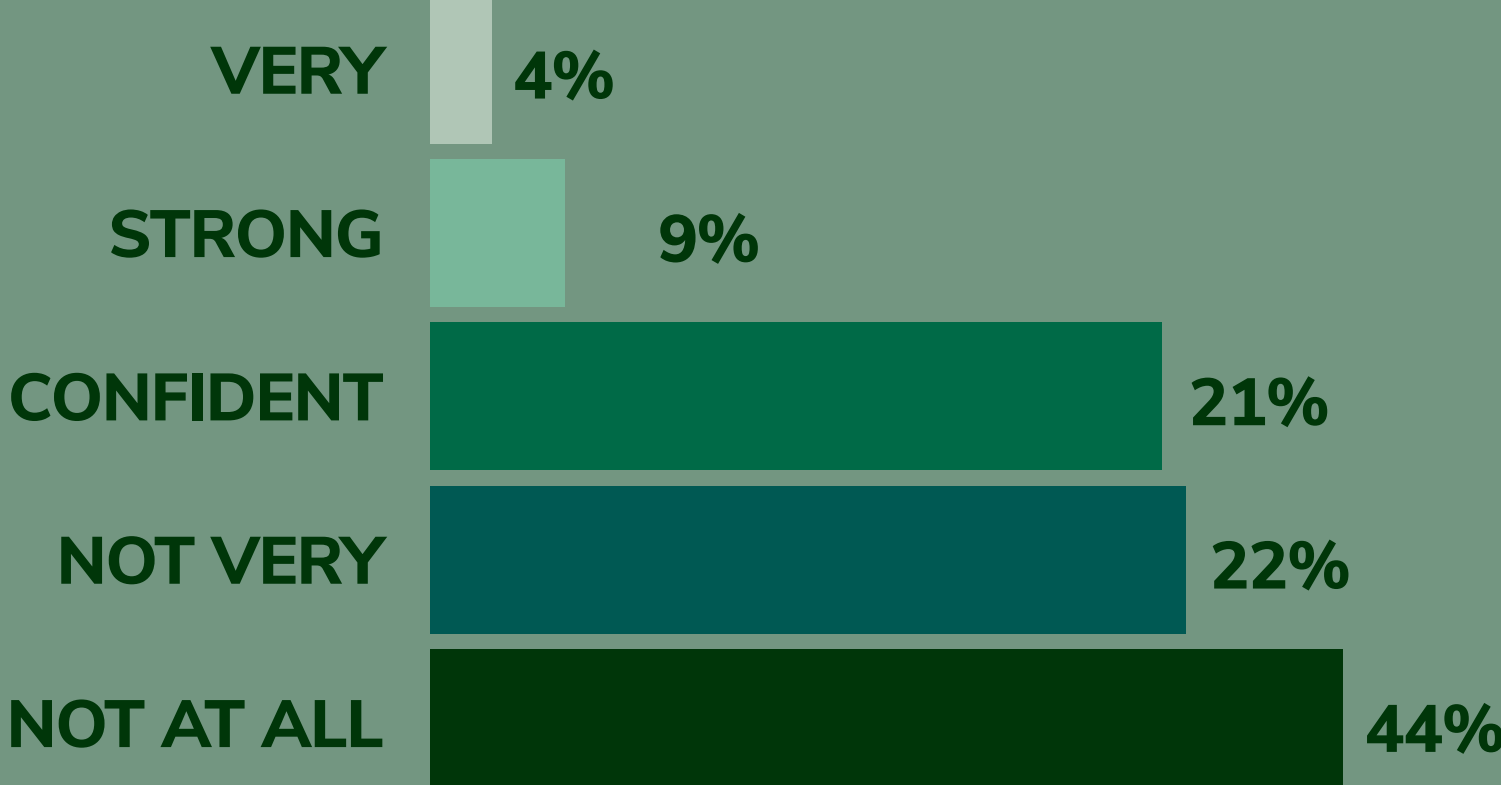

Australian Scouts urgent message to our leaders: Act on climate change now
