QUALIFICATIONS FOR VENTURER SCOUTS







Venturer Scouts can use their experiences and learning from participation in the youth program as evidence towards a range of Certificate II and Certificate III qualifications. The Scouts Australia Registered Training Organisation (RTO) is not the same as attending school, TAFE or other RTOs because the Scouts Australia RTO relies on experiential learning versus the alternate classroom model.

This means that by attending Venturer Scouts, participating fully in the program and engaging in the activities you like, you will experience things that help you learn and this learning can be recognised with qualifications. Some Venturer Scouts use vocational qualifications as part of or to supplement their senior secondary school certificate. (For example: HSC, VCE, QCE)
