BLUE: INFO FROM MOOT TEAM



- Q: Can CMT / IST see their path for PPA/PPT?
 - A: Not Yet
- 800 IST Job allocations have been sent out with the remainder pending across multiple contingents
- Q: When will my job be sent if I don't have it yet?
 - A: We will, soon, do a second round of preferences and allocations. By the end of this month, everyone will be allocated. Will communicate again this shortly.
- If you are unable to do your job before we leave please contact the freshdesk with the job and your reasons
- Slack Channels going out from this weekend for job areas and/or paths

Remember that you don't need to have the best job to have an amazing moot experience

General

- If there are **organised religious services** which you should be attending during moot which are not shown please raise a ticket to freshdesk this month so we can compile them.
- Each role should have some **time off / down time** throughout the Moot – pace yourself and know your limits when discussing when it is
- You will not be able to join the contingent (including pretour) if you have not completed your:
 - 3 mandatory modules
 - safe from harm training
 - have a valid Working with children / vulnerable people card (or application if accepted by your Branch) and the correct number is in the OLEMS system
 - Be a current financial member of your Branch
- There are no refunds given if you do not meet these requirements when attempting to **join** the contingent



Expectations

- You are able to self manage to a reasonable degree
 - You are expected to do the job allocated to you to a reasonable level
 - You will work to resolve issues which arise during the Moot
 - You will treat others with dignity and respect
 - You will conduct yourself in line with the Scouts Australia Code of Conduct and as a representative of Scouts Australia
-
- IST unable to meet these expectations will have this recorded on their permanent branch and national records.
 - You may be banned from future international contingents
 - You can be removed from the contingent
 - You may have your membership revoked



Escalation process - IST

What to escalate:

1. Mental / physical restrictions not being met
2. Religious needs
3. WHS violations which are likely to result in injury
4. Time off / sleep needs
5. Medical condition flare-up / exacerbation

How:

1. Can you resolve this yourself via sleep / food / etc
2. Try to resolve the issue with the appropriate person – team lead, site lead, path lead etc
3. Raise with contingent via hotline stating if it is urgent
4. If going off site due to medical please contact the Contingent Hotline as soon as possible

- ❖ Final night that we're in a hostel can we request to share with a participant as we are leaving on the same plane together.
 - Send an email through to Freshdesk with the request – CC in the person you want to share with so they're in the loop
- ❖ As a path advisor when will we know what path we're on?
 - We don't have a timeline yet – we've asked and been told its being worked on
- ❖ Is there a earliest time to arrive on the 24th?
 - 8am site opens but as we're not sure about leaving site for lunch we recommend after that
- ❖ What do we do if we're missing contingent gear?
 - Email the freshdesk with what you're missing
- ❖ Are they doing food like in iceland with a supermarket with "points" to spend and paths/patrols cook themselves?
 - Those allocated to main site will have meals from the canteen. For paths it will depend on the path location
- ❖ What is the safe from harm training? i know that the moot brought out some modules that are to be completed, is the safe from harm modules them?
 - The safe from harm module got sent directly from Moot – complete all the training they've sent you
- ❖ Participants got to somewhat choose their paths based on the 4 categories, will we get any influence on the paths we get?
 - Send Moot an email with any particular skills you have (eg. AA) and they may be able to put you on a matching path. Additionally if you cannot be on a remote path and are a PPA email them to confirm this requirement is being taken into account
