As the last day and night roll around, remember to look after yourself. Get some rest, stay hydrated, and make smart choices so you can enjoy the final moments and head home feeling your best.

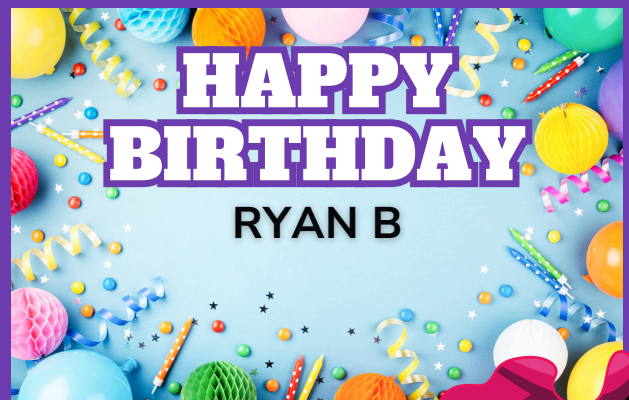
